One such was the SS GREAT BRITAIN. She had been launched in July 1843 and, after an interesting career, she found herself at Port Stanley in the Falkland Islands where a fire on board had damaged her beyond economic career. She was sold to the Falkland Islands Company and used, afloat, as a storage hulk (for coal and later wool) until 1937.
