Low-voltage wiring (carrying no more than 30 volts) must be buried at least 6 inches deep. Buried wiring runs that transition from underground to above ground must be protected in conduit from the required cover depth or 18 inches (whichever is less) to its termination point above ground, or at least 8 feet above grade.

Wiring Code Identification Information WIRE CODE IDENTIFICATION Each wire shown in the diagrams contains a code (Fig. 1) which identifies the main circuit, part of the main circuit, gauge of wire, and color. The color is shown as a two-letter code, which can be identified by referring to the Wire Color Code Chart (Fig. 2).

The difference is that, according to electrical code (NEC 320.12), an armored cable may not be used in damp or wet locations, in places where exposed to corrosive conditions, or places where damage might occur. By contrast, certain types of a conduit may be installed in such locations.

A GROUND is an additional wire, a backup path, that provides a bypass through which electricity can flow if there's a short in the system (i.e.: a 'live/hot' wire is touching metal that is touching skin). Instead of passing to earth through the person, it will go through the ground wire.

Connect the wires as they were in the old fixture. The ground wire is the bare copper wire and should be connected to the green grounding screw in the crossbar. Wire black to black and white to white. Have a helper hold the rest of the fixture while you connect the wires.

Bare aluminum electrical ground wires are sometimes found to have corroded entirely through where the wire touched a damp foundation wall. We also find that the ground wire between the electrical panel and a building water pipe or grounding electrode has become separated, loose, spliced, or lost entirely, as shown in our photo.
