Unit of Inquiry #6 Report \*Over the course of the school year, each grade level (1st-5th) will complete six units of inquiry (kindergarten implements only four units). The duration may vary according to student-initiated inquiries, action, and concept-based learning experiences.

Teachers select assessment strategies and design assessment instruments to clearly reflect the particular learning outcomes on which they intend to report (generally the central idea and lines of inquiry from a unit of inquiry).

More IB/PYP schools are adopting their report cards to fit the curriculum, but it is not a standard report card. Like most of you, we have each academic subject (Math, Reading, Writing, Science etc) and we give our students a 1-4 scale on each subheading within that report card.

### **Teaching the PYP: PYP and Report Cards**

The PYP culminates in the PYP exhibition: a collaborative, transdisciplinary, in-depth inquiry into real life issues or problems (IBO, 2008) and the means by which the inquiry-based learning which has taken place over the previous PYP years is assessed. The PYP exhibition is used flexibly in the students' final year of the PYP.

### **The impact of the PYP exhibition on the development of ...**

This part of the report card lists the specific PYP Attitudes (appreciation, empathy, commitment, enthusiasm, confidence, independence, cooperation, integrity, creativity, respect, curiosity, tolerance) that were connected to the units of inquiry taught during the term.

### **Understanding the PYP Report Card-Term2**

As well as developing conceptual understanding of materials and their properties, this unit also helps the students to develop their scientific inquiry skills with lots of opportunities to manipulate variables.
