The Vocational Guidance Movement was the precursor to career counseling. It begin in 1907, when the founding father of vocational guidance, Frank Parsons, created the first methodology of career guidance. In 1908, he began the Vocational Bureau of Boston, with a mission of aiding people to discover what careers were available.

One of the earliest examples of a true guidance system is that used in the German V-1 during World War II. The navigation system consisted of a simple gyroscope, an airspeed sensor, and an altimeter.
