Joel Snyder tells us that Audio Description (AD) provides a verbal version of the visual for the benefit of people who are blind or have low vision. Succinct descriptions precisely timed to occur only during the pauses in dialogue or significant sound elements of performing arts or in media allow persons with vision impairments to have greater access to the images integral to a given work of art.

Audio Description is a translation of images to words—the visual is made verbal—and has been shown to provide access to the wide range of media and arts (television, film, performing arts, museums) that comprise any culture.

The three different types of communication are verbal, nonverbal and visual. The two major forms of verbal communication are written (or typed) and oral. The major type of nonverbal is body language, especially visual cues. Visual communication, such as using pictures, graphs and the like, is fast gaining ground either to reinforce or to replace written messages.

Audio description is the use of words to convey visual images to people who do not have access to the images. It's a translation—from the visual to the verbal. The visual is made verbal — and aural A-U-R-A-L, he points to his ear, and oral O-R-A-L, he points to his mouth.
